

PGCC Nursing Program Admissions Process

Nursing Point System

Admissions and Selection Criteria

- Selection for admissions is based on a point system. Students with the highest points will be admitted first until all seats are filled.
- All qualifying prerequisites and supporting prerequisites must be completed with a grade of C or higher to be considered for admission.
- In the event of a point tie, the student's actual TEAS score percentage will be reviewed first, then the overall GPA will be reviewed second as the tiebreaker (whichever is higher).
- Petition Application Deadlines:
February 1 for fall and August 1 for spring
(*TEAS must be completed by the deadline.*)
- You must meet with a Health Sciences advisor by appointment in Navigate to go over the Nursing Point System.
- If you have questions, need help with student planning, or are interested in petitioning for the Nursing Program, email the Health Sciences advisor at healthscienceadvisor@pgcc.edu.

Orientation

- December for spring admission
- May for fall admission

After the deadline, students' names will be sent to Admissions for review first and the Nursing Committee will rank students on the results from Admissions for the Point System. Students who are accepted will receive the specific date for orientation.

Qualifying Prerequisites Attempts

(based on number of attempts per course)

ADD

- 1st attempt +4 pts
- 2nd attempt +2 pts
- 3rd attempt—ineligible/not accepted +0 pts

Standard Points

Qualifying Prerequisites GPA

ADD

- 4.00–above +4 pts
- 3.50 to 3.99 +3 pts
- 3.00 to 3.49 +2 pts
- 2.50 to 2.99 +1 pt

ATI-TEAS Exam Scoring

Students must get a minimum score of 70% in Reading

ADD

- Exemplary +4 pts
- Advanced +3 pts
- Proficient +2 pts
- Basic—ineligible/not accepted +0 pts
- Developmental—ineligible/not accepted +0 pts

Students will lose points

MINUS

- Other math -2 pts
- Other humanities -1 pt
- NUR-1020 Repeater -1 pt
