Job Readiness Training

Job Readiness Training consists of 10 sessions: 1 Blackboard training + 4 face-to-face sessions + 4 online sessions + 1 in-person assessment.

Important Notes:

- One absence is permissible for the ACT | SAT dates highlighted above. Instructors will provide guidance on make-up assignments.
- Students are **not** permitted to miss the first two days of class for any reason. The first day of class is Blackboard training at Prince George's Community College.
- <u>Blackboard use is mandatory</u>. Assistance with setting up and using Blackboard is limited once the class begins.
- Attendance in the Parent Orientation is strongly suggested. Program staff are **not permitted** to answer questions from parents and other third parties outside of the Q and A and parent orientation sessions.
- Make-up dates for <u>unscheduled</u> site closures "*" are listed above. Students are required to make-up classes missed due to site closures (such as inclement weather).
- January 19 and February 16 are not legal holidays; classes are in session.
