Introduction to Security Clearances and Background Checks (INT-1902/CAM-300)

The need for a security status is prevalent in all industries. All occupational specialties require employers to have a pool of potential employees who have the ability to meet and pass the challenges of rigorous background checks and security clearance screening processes.

This course will prepare students to navigate the delicate and often complex process of seeking, obtaining, and maintaining a security clearance. Emphasis will be placed on how to recognize, identify, and avoid actions and behaviors that hinder the process. It is designed for those seeking employment with the federal government or contractors for the intelligence community; diplomatic and other government agencies; law enforcement; and the health care industry.
