APPLICABLE PROVISIONS:

- 1 Degrees are applicable only if earned at accredited institutions and verified with *official* transcripts.
- 2 Pertinent professional experience may be substituted for the master's degree at the discretion of the Vice President.
- 3 Specialized doctoral degree (J.D., M.D., M.F.A. etc.) are applicable to doctoral placement only for teaching assignments directly relevant to the degree; otherwise, such degrees are equated to the master's degree for placement. Faculty who are assigned to teach ACC 221 - Federal Income Tax and have a JD degree will be paid at the JD level.
- 4 This schedule is applicable for all credit teaching assignments undertaken by College employees who are not full-time, 10 month contract teaching faculty.
- 5 Satisfactory completion of 30 or more semester hours of relevant academic study in an accredited doctoral program may, at the discretion of the Vice President, be determined to meet master's degree requirement.
- 6 Emeritus status is awarded upon recommendation of the Dean to a retired full-time faculty member who has completed at least 20 year of pre-retirement teaching service at PGCC: such appointment does not provide any guarantee of teaching assignment availability and continuation of emeritus status requires the maintenance of teaching evaluations deemed by the Dean to be consistent with this recognition.
