WHAT ARE ESL PATHWAYS?

Career Pathways ESL classes are for you if:

- You are an intermediate or advanced English language learner
- You want to develop English language skills for employment
- You want to obtain introductory certificates in: Childcare, Healthcare, Culinary Arts or Construction. These certificates are nationally recognized and industry specific

Prerequisites:

- ESL English in America – students take this class first. Students will learn to write a resume and practice interview skills, and learn about the American workplace, healthcare system, government and schools

Program Requirements:

To register for this program, participants must:

- Be at least 18 years of age and a Maryland resident
- Have a high school diploma
- Be eligible to work in the United States
- Have an intermediate or advanced level of English skills (ESL Level of 4 or higher)

- Certified Nursing Assistant – earn a CNA certificate from the Maryland Board of Nursing
