
In order to address the continuing educational needs of its nursing students, Prince George's Community College ("PGCC") enters into a partnership agreement with York College of Pennsylvania ("YCP").

YCP is committed to creating the most cost-effective and flexible RN to BSN program in the region, while delivering the highest quality nursing education backed by CCNE accreditation. The online RN to BSN program provides nurses the ability to complete their bachelor's degree in as little as twelve months.

Through this partnership, YCP will offer a preferred tuition rate to graduates from PGCC who are admitted to the program at a rate of \$9,900 for the 10 core nursing curriculum courses (a rate of \$330/credit hour). The preferred tuition rate will also be extended to family members of those graduates who hold a valid nursing license and are admitted to the RN to BSN program. This partnership underscores PGCC's commitment to the professional growth and continuing education of its nursing graduates.

To facilitate access to, and interest in, YCP's RN to BSN program, PGCC agrees to designate a staff member to act as program coordinator to communicate this new partnership internally to students and graduates via email and in-person announcements. In addition, this program coordinator will help facilitate quarterly information sessions on site or digitally through Zoom, Skype, WebEx, where YCP representatives can meet prospective students face to face to share information and answer questions. Upon confirmation of internal communication of the program and partnership, graduates and family members of graduates will have access to the preferred tuition rate.

PGCC will not be party to the financial or academic relationship between an admitted or enrolled student and York regardless of whether that person is a PGCC student or family member of a student. The affiliation agreement between PGCC and York simply extends the opportunity for a preferred tuition rate to PGCC students or family members of students.
